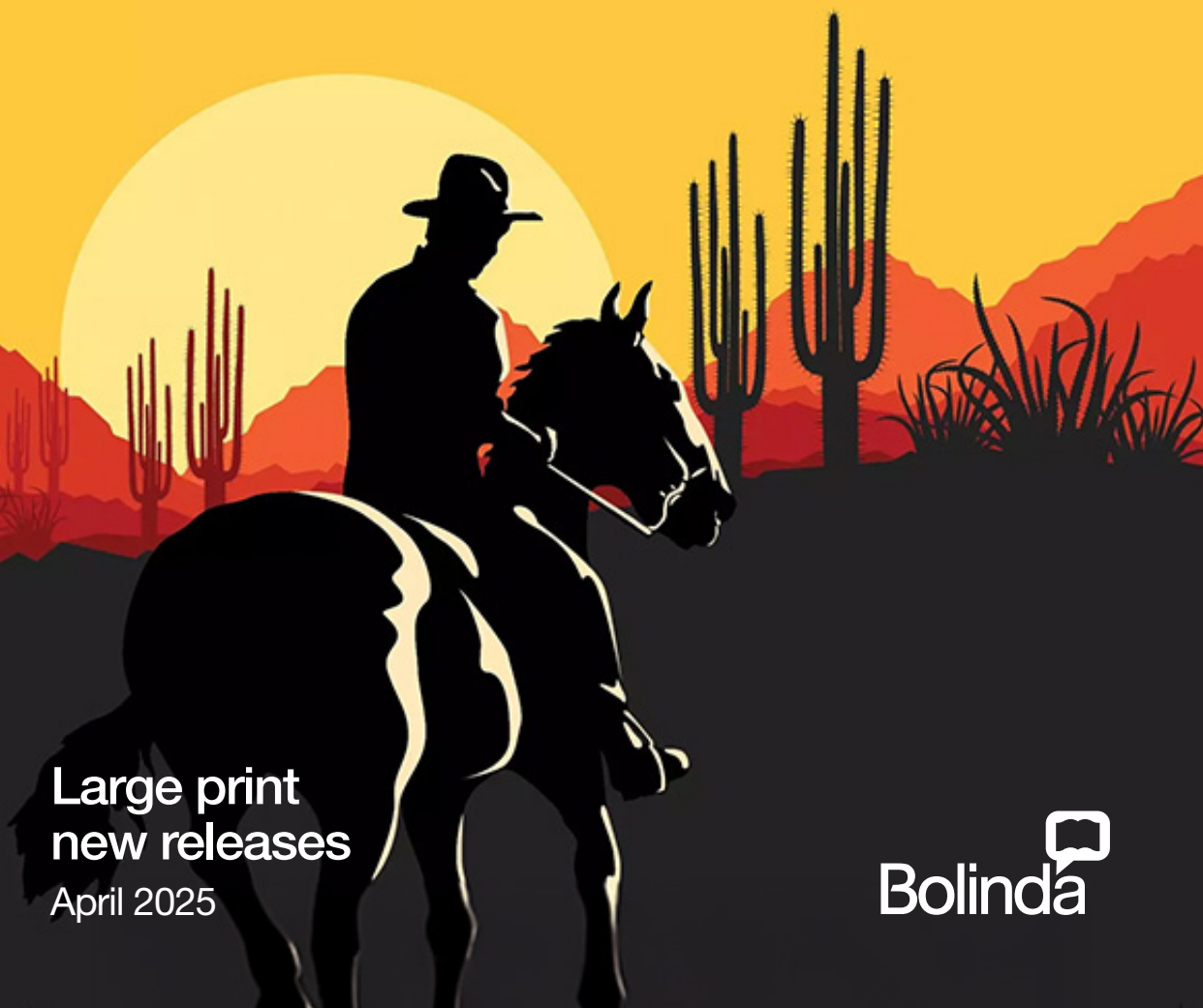

Far from Home

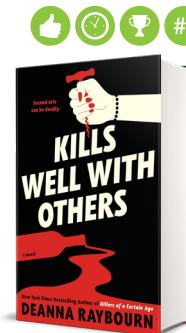
Danielle Steel
